

## Consent Notices

Transmission Service over the Ameren transmission system is obtained from MISO pursuant to a MISO tariff. Ameren believes it can not provide any preferences with respect to transmission service provided by MISO under its tariff, but out of an abundance of caution, Ameren will require customers that request Ameren's Transmission Function to provide customer specific non-public Transmission Function Information to a designated Ameren Marketing Function to sign a consent form.

FERC Standards of Conduct, Section 358.7(c): a transmission customer may voluntarily consent, in writing, to allow the transmission provider to disclose the transmission customer's non-public information to the transmission provider's marketing function employees. If the transmission customer authorizes the transmission provider to disclose its information to marketing function employees, the transmission provider must post notice on its Internet website of that consent along with a statement that it did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate-related, in exchange for that voluntary consent.

On October 21, 2009 U.S. Steel provided its voluntary consent to allow Ameren Services Company to share certain transmission and other customer information with the Ameren Illinois Utilities Power Supply Acquisition group. Ameren Services Company did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate related, in exchange for that voluntary consent.
