Here are some ways to save energy and money now:



Replace your five most frequently used light fixtures or bulbs with ENERGY STAR® certified bulbs and you can save \$75 per year.



Help keep your home cool in the summer by closing your shades or blinds during the day. This can lead to your house being 10 to 15 degrees cooler.



Keep your thermostat at 78° in the summer and 68° in the winter. The lower the temperature difference between inside and outside your house, the less energy you will consume.



In the summer, use appliances that generate heat during the early morning or evening hours when it's cooler.

INCOME ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS

Ameren Missouri supports a variety of programs to help our customers in need. Apply for the following programs at an agency near you. You can find a list of agencies at **AmerenMissouri.com/EnergyAssistance** or by contacting the United Way at **2.1.1**. or **211Helps.org**.

- Dollar More: The Ameren Missouri Dollar More program assists families with their home energy costs, through voluntary and company donations.
- Keeping Current: A program that helps make your monthly bill more affordable. It includes a monthly bill credit and past due balance reduction with on-time payments.
- Keeping Cool: This program provides an electric bill credit of \$25 in June, July and August for 2 years.
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
 (LIHEAP): Administered by the Missouri Family Services
 Division. Eligible customers can receive up to \$800
 in the winter and \$300 in the summer. To apply, call

- Weatherization Program: Find energy savings through home improvements like caulking and insulation for homeowners and renters through local agencies.
