- 1. Add the REF12 code to the REF02 of the REF*TD Reason for Change segment to allow ComEd to send 814C-Request transactions for their billing system conversion.
- 2. Use Ref 45 for old CIMS account numbers.
- 3. Modify the verbiage in the second in gray bar section to include the possibility of negative and/or zero values.
- 4. Modify 814C-Request for demand response for Rider RMUD.
- 5. Eliminate the SAC08, SAC09 and SAC10 and only use the SAC05 and SAC15.
- **6.** Do not sending interval information for CS pseudo meter.

Detailed Explanation (Exactly what change is required? To which Illinois CPWG Standards? Why?):

- 1. ComEd is implementing a new billing system which is going to result in customer account number changes. Each new account number needs to be sent via an EDI814C-Request transaction to the RES that supplies that customer. The Reason for Change segment (REF*TD) will need to include a new code REF12 in the REF02.
- 2. As a result of the Illinois Clean Energy Law, ComEd changed how the Peak Load Contributions/Network Service Load values are calculated for net metering customers which resulted in negatives and or zeros values.
- 3. Change verbiage to EDI Guide to include: "Setting this segment to "S" requires the RES to request interval details via the AMI Data Preference Identifier (DAILY or MONTHLY). If the RES wishes to activate both the AMI Data Preference Identifier and the DR Indicator post enrollment, both requests should be made in the same EDI transaction.
- 4. Remove verbiage that ComEd will remove customer from Demand Response.
- 5. Eliminate the SAC08, SAC09 and SAC10 and only use the SAC05 and SAC15 for bill print.
- 6. ComEd will no longer send intervals for CS pseudo meters for it is not being used for supplier billing.
