

## RULES TO LIVE BY - BUSINESS AND CORPORATE SERVICES

## The actions to take on Rules to Live By violations are as follows:

- 1. When a Rule to Live By violation is observed, stop the job.
- 2. Contact the employee's supervisor and advise them of the situation.
- 3. A fact-finding meeting will take place to determine the facts of the incident.
- 4. Appropriate actions will take place based on fact finding.

## The following Rules to Live By are applicable to all Business and Corporate Services employees:

- Wear Seat Belts, as required.
- **Electrical Safety** Follow the proper procedures and wear the proper personal protective equipment when working with energized equipment.
- **Use Fall Protection, when required** use fall protection when there is a risk of a fall that is greater than 6 feet.
- Wear FR Apparel, as required.
- Follow Workers Protection Assurance (WPA Lock Out/Tag Out) work practices –
  never violate a tag, lock or tag-out device that is used for employee protection.
- Rigging/Hoisting avoid walking, working or standing under a suspended load.
- Observe all other Business Lines' Rules to Live By when working in their areas.
- 1. "Rules to Live By" are part of the Ameren Safety Initiative to improve safety performance throughout the Company. Each division is to identify a limited number of safety rules that, if violated, could result in death or serious injury.
- 2. "Rules to Live By" are developed to focus attention on a limited number of very important safety rules and provide definite consequences if the rules are violated.
- 3. <u>Violation of the "Rules to Live By" may result in Disciplinary Action up to and including discharge</u>. As always, consequences will be commensurate with the infraction.
