Spring Energy Efficiency Checklist

As the days get longer and flowers start to bloom, give your home a fresh start with a quick energy checkup this spring. Use the checklist below to boost comfort and trim energy usage all season:

- 1. Switch to energy-efficient LED light bulbs.
- 2. Use wool dryer balls instead of dryer sheets to reduce drying time.
- 3. Lower your water heater temperature.
- 4. Use ceiling fans to circulate air.
- 5. Seal air leaks with caulk or weatherstripping.
- 6. Use smart power strips to cut standby power.
- 7. Program a smart thermostat.
- 8. Keep the damper closed when not using your fireplace.
- 9. Replace your HVAC filter every season.
- 10. Open your blinds and curtains during the day to utilize sunlight; close them at night to retain heat.
