



Local Public Hearings Notice

Ameren Missouri requested permission from the Missouri Public Service Commission to build three new battery energy storage systems, two new solar generation facilities, and a new switching station. The battery facilities are to be located at Ameren Missouri's Castle Bluff Energy Center in St. Louis County, near the Audrain Energy Center in Audrain County, and in Lincoln County. The switching station will be located next to the Lincoln County battery system site. The solar facilities are in Lincoln and Stoddard counties.
