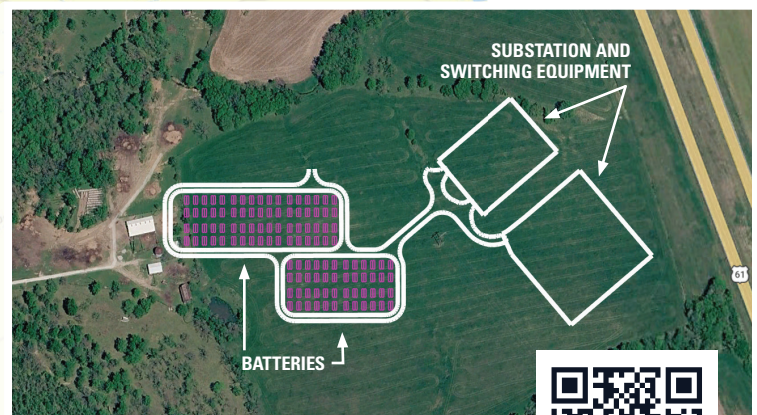
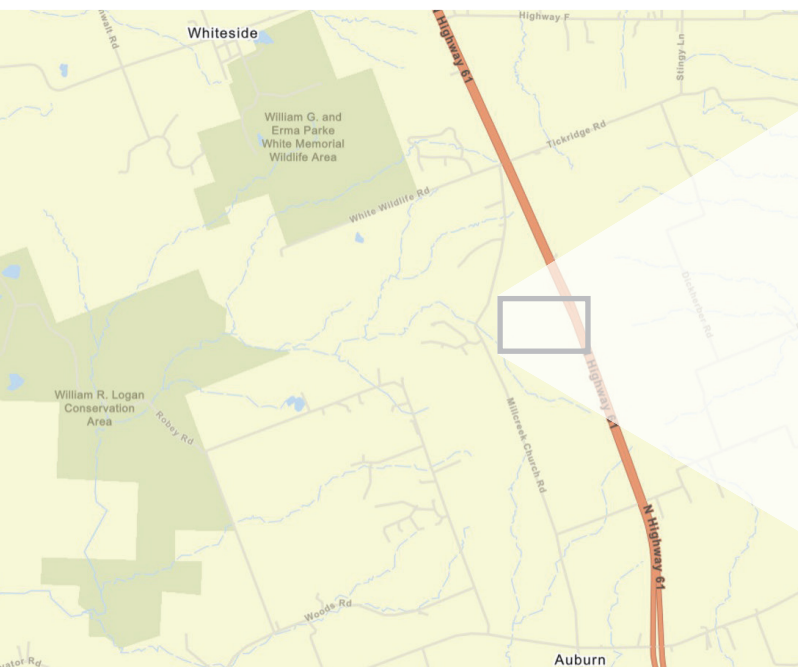

The proposed 250-megawatt facility would be located on Ameren Missouri-owned property west of Highway 61 and just south of Tickridge Road.

The battery equipment is expected to occupy approximately 12 acres, with an additional 12 acres for substation and switching equipment. An additional 265 acres are expected to remain largely undeveloped, providing natural terrain and forested areas to help screen the facility and maintain separation from neighboring land uses.
