814 Enrollment Response:

- Updated notes to remove Community Solar information for ComEd as this detail is no longer sent to the RES.
- Added Utility DUNS Numbers to the N1*8S.
- Changed Net Meter Contract Indicator (REF*NM)'s purpose from identifying only for ComEd whether a RES established a Net Meter contract to being used by both utilities to identify either that there is no net metering or the type of net metering. This is used to determine whether RES needs to provide kWh or monetary credit and whether kWh credits expire.
- Removed Special Meter Configuration Code "VO" which was used to identify ComEd's pseudo meters for Community Solar.
- Added Net Meter Contract Start Date (DTM*276) for ComEd.
- Updated examples to match current production and removed several examples.

- Updated Notes section and for ComEd to allow the AMI Data Preference Identifier for Small Commercial accounts.
- Changed Net Meter Contract Indicator (REF*NM)'s purpose from identifying only for ComEd whether a RES established a Net Meter contract to being used by both utilities to identify either that there is no net metering or the type of net metering. This is used to determine whether RES needs to provide kWh or monetary credit and whether kWh credits expire. The new field name is Net Meter Classification.

- Removed Special Meter Configuration Code "VO" which was used to identify ComEd's pseudo meters for Community Solar.
- Updated examples based on production data.

- Added new SAC04 code CRE005 for Net metering Credit
- Administrative cleanup (updated examples, etc.)

867 Monthly Usage

- Corrected ANSI X12 fields such as minimum/maximum and use.
- Added Net Meter Classification (REF*NM).
- Changed Net Meter Anniversary Month to be applicable to ComEd as well as Ameren. Also added use of code 00.
- Changed Community Solar Participant Indicator to Optional.
- Changed QTY for Total Off-Site Generation to Optional with a note that this will stop being sent.
- Changed Starting Bank QTY and MEA to be required for ComEd (previously only required for Ameren) when an Account/Service Point has net metering where kWh is banked. Also changed QTY02 and MEA03 to remove reference to off-site generation.
- Added Ending Bank QTY and MEA.

- Removed Special Meter Configuration Code “VO” which was used to identify ComEd’s pseudo meters for Community Solar.
- Updated examples based on production data.
