Rules

- New construction is not permitted. The space that will be conditioned by the new equipment must have been conditioned for the past 12 months to allow for a usage analysis.
- To qualify for PAYS financing, the usage analysis must demonstrate that the project will result in estimated savings.
- To be eligible for the rebate, the new equipment must meet efficiency requirements as listed on the rebate chart.
- Ameren Missouri does not promote fuel switching or load building. The aim of this program is not to encourage customers to use a different fuel source but to subsidize part of the cost of a more efficient unit once a fuel source has been selected.
- A home with existing non-electric heat must maintain that heat source (as primary or backup) in order to be eligible for the program.
- For GSHP to be eligible for a rebate, the AHRI certificate for the system must meet AHRI EER2 23+.
- GSHP loop systems do not need to be replaced, but the heat pump, circulation pumps and controller must be upgraded and meet AHRI EER2 23+.
- *Mini-split systems can be installed in spaces that have been conditioned for at least 12 months without removing existing equipment.
