## Do-It-Yourself Savings During the Winter

-  Unplug unused electronics because even if they are turned off, they are still drawing power, wasting energy and hiking up your power bill.
-  Keep your fireplace damper closed unless a fire is burning, so heat doesn't escape up the chimney.

-  Remove dust and pet hair to allow heat to easily flow through vents and remove furniture or curtains blocking air flow.
-  Replace the filter in your furnace before you start heating your home or business.
-  Prevent cold air from leaking in by sealing any openings around windows and doors with caulk or weather stripping.
