



SMELL GAS? ACT FAST!

If you smell, hear or see what could be a natural gas leak in your area, act fast and:

1. Leave the premises immediately, heading upwind and taking all people and pets with you. Watch for Ameren to arrive.



2. While evacuating, do not turn on/off lights or operate anything that could cause a spark. Do not open windows or doors to ventilate the property.



3. At a safe distance, call Ameren at the number listed for your state:

4. Do not re-enter the property for any reason until Ameren personnel tell you that it is safe to return.

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SEE:

If you see an unusual area of dead vegetation, blowing dirt or bubbling water, it could be a natural gas leak.

HEAR:

If you hear a hissing or roaring sound, it could be a natural gas leak.

SMELL:

If you smell a distinct rotten egg odor, it could be a natural gas leak. We add the odor to keep you safe.



Scratch the blue flame to help you recognize what natural gas smells like.
