

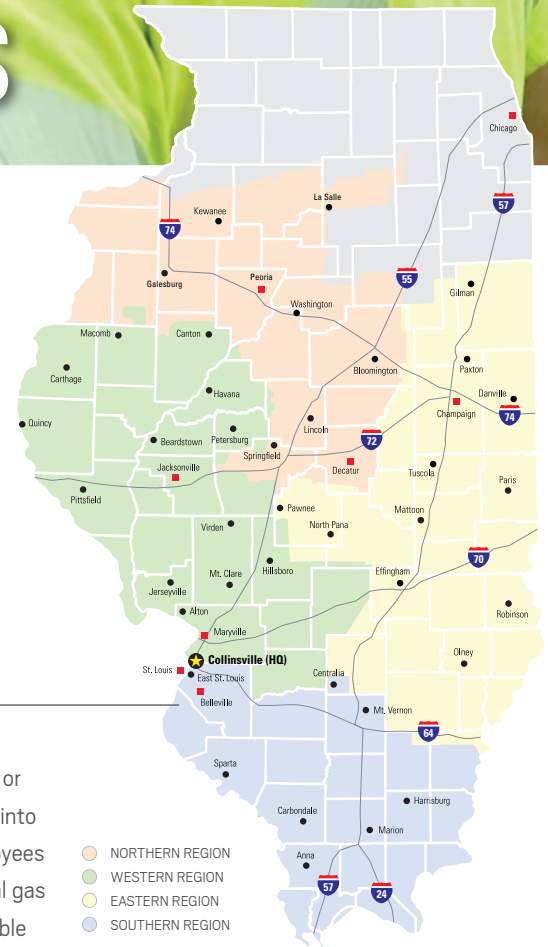


# AMEREN ILLINOIS

## COMPANY OVERVIEW

Headquartered in Collinsville, Ameren Illinois is the state's second largest regulated energy company and the only energy company in the state delivering both natural gas and electricity to its customers. Ameren Illinois serves 1.2 million electric customers and more than 800,000 natural gas customers in central and southern Illinois. As an energy delivery company, Ameren Illinois owns and maintains the wires, poles, substations and enabling technology that distributes power to homes and businesses. Ameren Illinois is a subsidiary of St. Louis-based Ameren Corporation.



## SERVICE TERRITORY

Our service territory spans 43,700 square miles, or about three-quarters of the state, and is divided into four operational regions. More than 3,300 employees are working to strengthen our electric and natural gas infrastructure for the future, while providing reliable energy and excellent service.





## ENERGY EFFICIENCY

We're committed to helping customers find ways to improve comfort, manage usage and reduce costs. Last year, the Ameren Illinois Energy Efficiency Program saved our customers more than \$60 million on their bills from energy efficiency upgrades. ## CLEAN ENERGY

Ameren Illinois has established a multi-year plan to strengthen the reliability and resiliency of the electric grid and prepare for an equitable transition to clean energy. The plan includes customer-focused programs and investments which will enable Ameren Illinois to continue to deliver safe, secure, and reliable power in an equitable and cost-effective manner. It also includes initiatives to facilitate the adoption and development of local, clean energy generation, promote the long-term growth of cleaner energy, and operate the enabling infrastructure that will support electrification of the downstate Illinois economy. The new multi-year grid planning and ratemaking process was established under the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act, a state law that aims to move Illinois to 100% carbon-free energy sources by 2050.



## COMMUNITY SOLAR

Approximately 7,500 Ameren Illinois electric customers are currently getting a portion of their energy output from a qualifying generator without having to install solar panels or other renewable generation — regardless of where in Ameren Illinois' service territory that generator is located. Solar developers, using the Community Solar program and Renewable Energy Credits from Ameren Illinois via the Illinois Power Agency's incentive programs, are finishing construction of their facilities with about 35 — and growing — connected to the Ameren Illinois grid.



## COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Ameren Illinois is dedicated to fostering economic empowerment, building thriving communities, and providing philanthropic support to deliver critical needs to the most vulnerable. Annually, Ameren Illinois contributes more than \$3 million to more than 400 organizations throughout central and southern Illinois. In addition, employees serve on local boards and volunteer their time and talents to build stronger communities.



## ELECTRIC

We deliver safe, reliable electric service to more than 1,200 communities in 89 counties. Our complex delivery system includes about approximately 4,600 miles of electric transmission lines, 46,000 miles of distribution lines (16% underground), 1,500 electric substations and more than 1.3 million power poles.



## NATURAL GAS

Ameren Illinois maintains 18,700 miles of natural gas transmission and distribution mains and 12 underground natural gas storage fields with a total capacity of approximately 24 billion cubic feet.
