2019-2023 Ameren Missouri Solar Rebates

- ➤ Solar Rebates are part of the Smart Energy Plan (SB564) that was passed by the Missouri Legislature in May, 2018.
- > \$28 million dollars over 5 years according to the following schedule:
 - o 2019 \$10.0 million
 - o 2020 \$5.6 million
 - o 2021 \$5.6 million
 - o 2022 \$5.6 million
 - o 2023 \$0.4 million
 - o Low-Income (2019-2023) \$0.8 million
- Solar Rebate Tariff became effective on September 28, 2018
- Solar Rebate, Net Metering, and Qualifying Facilities applications are on line at https://www.ameren.com/missouri/residential/clean-energy-customer-programs/solar/customer-owned-solar
- Funding availability is displayed on the application website and customers are told, at the time of application, if they have received funding.
- ➤ The solar rebate applies to systems operational on or after January 1, 2019.
- A system is considered operational after the bi-directional meter is installed. If no meter is required then it is when completed Sections E and F of a net metering or qualifying facilities application are returned to Ameren Missouri.
- ➤ If a customer has a Smart Meter installed, their system is considered operational after it is inspected.
- ➤ The rebate schedule is based on when the system becomes operational as follows:
 - o January 1, 2019-June 30, 2019--\$0.50 per watt
 - July 1, 2019-December 31, 2023--\$0.25 per watt

- ➤ Maximum solar system size for a solar rebate for a Residential customer is 25 kW
- Maximum solar system size for a solar rebate for a Commercial or Industrial customer is 150 kW.
- Maximum solar system size to qualify for net metering is up to the load of the facility or 100 KW.
