If you have critical, life-sustaining medical equipment that requires electricity, register to receive updates in case of a planned outage.



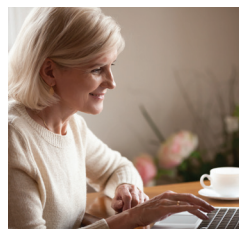
Critical Medical Needs and Medical Hardship Program
