Timeline





Construction

- Construction will include:
 - Installing new storm-resistant poles and smart technology
 - Replacing equipment near your home or business
 - Switching homes and businesses over to new substation
- Most work will happen during the day
- You may see large equipment, crews along the road, temporary lane closures, noise and dust.











Construction

- An Ameren Missouri contractor will notify you with a knock on your door 24-48 hours in advance of any work on/near your property.
- If you're not home, we'll leave a door hanger on your door.
- You will always have safe access to their home or business.
- We'll let you know when all upgrades are complete. If we do work on your property, we will restore it.













Planned Power Outages



- The Pershall Project requires a few short, planned power outages so that our crews can install new equipment and make upgrades.
- We anticipate each planned outage may last up to four hours.
- We will communicate with you in advance so that your family or business has time to make arrangements.









Notifications



Once we start work, look for postcards and door hangers to keep you informed.



We will also give you a call or text alert before a planned power outage if you'd like – just sign up for alerts on your Ameren Missouri account. Once enrolled, you will receive two automated calls on the day of the outage – one sharing the time work will start and another when we have restored your power.
